**LEVELS AND TIME LIMITS**

*Brass/Percussion* (one level)

Grades 9-12      10 minutes

*Woodwinds:*

Grades 7-8      7 minutes

Grades 9-10      8 minutes

Grades 11-12      10 minutes

**REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS**

Selection(s) or movement(s) displaying contrasting styles or tempi.

Memorization is most acceptable, but not required.

Furnish one published score for the judges. If a photocopy must be used, the student's application must be accompanied by the NVMTA Photocopy Release, signed by a parent or teacher. Students using photocopies either for themselves or the judges without having provided the Photocopy Release by the application deadline may play for comments but will not be eligible to compete.

**ELIGIBILITY**

Participants must have studied with the entering teacher as their principal teacher of the instrument played and repertoire to be performed for the 6 months preceding the event, and the teacher must be an active member of NVMTA (as defined in the bylaws).

Previous first-place winners may not compete again in the same level, but with chairman's consent may compete in a higher level.

**APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

Use NVMTA General Application Form. Include a stamped, self-addressed envelope (at least 6" x 9"). Mail along with your check (one check per studio, payable to NVMTA) to: Kristen Sheridan, 9727 Aspen Hollow Way, Fairfax VA 22032.

**TEACHER GUIDELINES**

Student must provide accompanist, if needed.

All parent or student questions about an event should be handled by the teacher. Teachers should never give parents or students the phone numbers or e-mail addresses of chairmen. Chairmen have no obligation to respond to parent or student inquiries.

The final decision on scheduling and related aspects of each event rests with the chairman.
