## **LEVELS AND TIME LIMITS**

Elementary	Grades 6 and under	8 minutes
Intermediate	Grades 7-9	13 minutes
Senior	Grades 10-12	20 minutes

## **REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS**

No arrangements. Furnish one published score for the judges. If a photocopy must be used, the student's application must be accompanied by the NVMTA Photocopy Release, signed by a parent or teacher. Students using photocopies either for themselves or the judges without having provided the Photocopy Release by the application deadline may play for comments but will not be eligible to compete.

*Elementary and Intermediate.* Three pieces representing three of the following four periods: Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Contemporary.

*Senior.* Four works: (1) A sonata movement by Haydn, Clementi, Mozart, Beethoven or early Schubert; (2) a piece from the Baroque period, (3) a piece from the Romantic period, and (4) a piece from the Impressionistic period or from the 20th or 21st century.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Participants must have studied with their current teacher for the 6 months preceding the event and the teacher must be an active member of NVMTA (as defined in the bylaws).

Previous first-place winners may not compete again in the same level, and they must wait until they are eligible for the next level in order to participate again.

## **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

Use NVMTA General Application Form. If e-mail notification of your scheduled performance time is not acceptable, include a stamped, self-addressed business envelope with your application. Mail along with your check (one check per studio, payable to NVMTA) to Haewon Moon, 9808 Vertain Court, Fairfax, VA 22032.

## **TEACHER GUIDELINES**

No repertoire changes may be made after the postmark deadline.

Participating teachers are expected to assist the chair as needed. These assignments are based on the number of students enrolled, regardless of subsequent student withdrawals.

Any teacher who fails to carry out the assigned duties and who has not provided a substitute approved by the chairman may not enter students in that event in the following year.

All parent or student questions about an event should be handled by the teacher. Teachers should never give parents or students the phone numbers or e-mail addresses of chairmen. Chairmen have no obligation to respond to parent or student inquiries.

The final decision on scheduling and related aspects of each event rests with the chairman.
