**REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS**

One composition by J. S. Bach and either a second composition by J. S. Bach or a work by another Baroque composer (sons of Bach are not considered Baroque composers for this Festival).

NVMTA supports the use of published musical scores. If a photocopy must be used, the student's application must be accompanied by the NVMTA Photocopy Release, signed by a parent or teacher. Students using photocopies either for themselves or the judges without having provided the Photocopy Release by the application deadline may play for comments but will not be eligible to compete.

**ELIGIBILITY**

Open to all ages, including adults, all instruments and chamber music groups.

Students may play in either noncompetitive or competitive groups. Participants in the competitive groups must have studied with their current teacher for the 6 months preceding the event, and the teacher must be an active member of NVMTA (as defined in the bylaws).

Students who play in the recital one year may not audition for it the following year, but they may enter the noncompetitive section.

**TEACHER GUIDELINES**

Participating teachers must contribute by judging or working in the audit room on festival day *or* they must find a substitute before submitting student applications. Teachers should expect to work a minimum of 2 hours. Teachers entering 12 or more students will be expected to work all day.

Any teacher who fails to appear on the day of the event to carry out the assigned duties and who has not provided a substitute approved by the chairman will pay NVMTA a fine of \$100 per three-hour session or fraction thereof, to be used as reimbursement for substitutes. A teacher who fails to pay the fine may not enter students in that event in the following year.

All parent or student questions about an event should be handled by the teacher. Teachers should never give parents or students the phone numbers or e-mail addresses of chairmen. Chairmen have no obligation to respond to parent or student inquiries.

The final decision on scheduling and related aspects of each event rests with the chairman.

**AWARDS**

Selected students in the competitive groups will be nominated for the concert performance. Students who play in the morning will have a second audition at noon. Afternoon students' second audition will be at 3:00 pm. Winners of the second auditions will be presented in recital the same evening.

**NOTE**

A harpsichord will be available for students to try.
