**ELIGIBILITY**

Students of any age whose teacher belongs to NVMTA and has paid Junior Club dues to VFMC Treasurer by November 30, 2009. Juniors who enter must be 19 years of age as of July 1 of the festival year or have completed high school, whichever comes last. Adult entrants must be out of high school and studying with a federated teacher.

**APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

Participating teachers must be members of a federated club. Teachers who have paid their NVMTA dues for the current year are automatically members in good standing of a federated Senior Club. To enter your students in the Spring Festival you must federate them as a Junior Club, paying dues for each participant to the Virginia Federation of Music Clubs by November 30.
